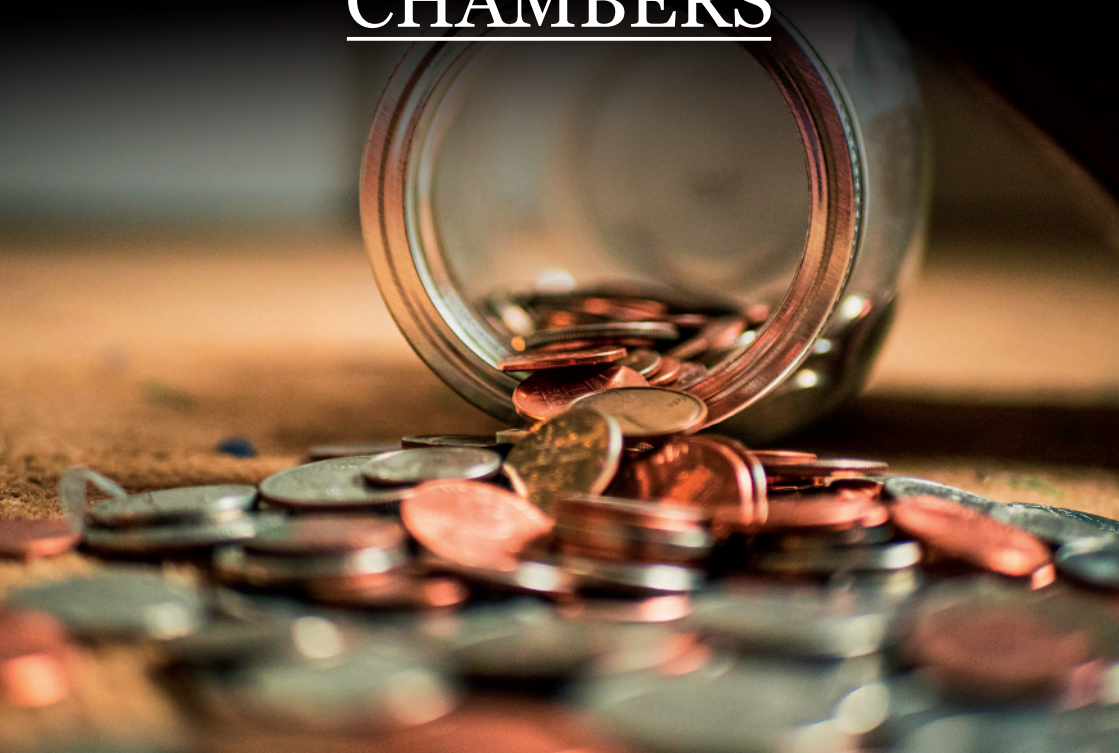

Is the threshold for conduct arguments set too high? Is it time for domestic abuse to be accepted as 'relevant conduct'?

The threshold for conduct arguments in financial remedy cases is generally considered high, and domestic abuse is often not accepted as relevant conduct.

Recent cases, such as *N v J*, have clarified that conduct related to domestic abuse does not meet the stringent criteria set by the Matrimonial Causes Act 1973. John will consider is it set too high and is it time for a change ?
